

LEGENDS' CUP CHAMPIONSHIPS & JUBILEE

FAQ's (As of 3/1/10)

- Q With the groups, what will the time limit be?**
A The time limits are in the Rulebook which is posted on www.batontwirlingnetwork.com with all the other pertinent information.
- Q All organizations do it differently, what date determines my child's age for the competition?**
A Participants will compete the age they are on May 29, 2010.
- Q If I enter my daughter in two baton events her total cost would be \$50?**
A Yes, \$25 each.
- Q If I wanted to go the one day the best thing to do is to get the bracelet ahead of time correct?**
A Yes.
- Q Do you send door admission bracelets ahead of time with a confirmation of what events entered?**
A You will receive an email confirmation for your daughter's entry and anything else you paid for. You will then pick up the bracelets (competitors will receive one also) at the Registration table on site.
- Q Also if somebody wanted to order a bracelet ahead of time but is not competing can they do that?**
A Absolutely. If they will be with you, you can order it with your OR they can print out the order form and mail it in.
- Q Also what is the deadline for ordering?**
A All forms are due April 1, 2010.
- Q Will there be a program book that my daughter would get at the contest giving her the information on where to go and lanes, etc?**
A We will post the order of appearance at the competition and there will be a souvenir program on sale as well. Competitors can take out ads and booster in the program. The form is in the entry packet.
- Q Are all organizations going to be competing against each other, for instance USTA allows gymnastic moves and NBTA does not so will they be judged based on their organization?**
A Yes all organizations will come together for the events. Gymnastics will be allowed by all as long as the participant and their coach feel that the participant is properly trained to include the move(s) in their routine.
- Q Will the groups be broken up into Small & Large?**
A If the entries warrant...yes. Otherwise, this first year there will only be one category per event.
- Q Are there events for say, a solo drummer, to compete in?**
A Not this initial year, sorry BUT we are working toward adding those types of events; drummer, rifle, flag and dance, to next year's competition.

Q Will there be practice space available?

A Yes, but percussion groups will have to practice outside or in a separate provided space.

Q Can groups competing have a booth at the event?

A Yes, if they take vendor space. This is a great way to share merchandise.

Q What happens if the same person wins the individual Freestyle and One Baton titles in the preliminary rounds for the Legends' Cup?

A That person will have to decide which they will compete with in the finals. In the event they decide NOT to select for the final round, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place will compete in the finals.

Q Will the finals definitely be on Sunday?

A Unless there are so many entries we run out of time and have to move the finals to Monday morning, YES, the finals will happen last thing on Sunday. We want everyone to enjoy Memorial Day on the Pier.

Q What will you do in the finals round if there is a tie for first place?

A A tie in the final round will be handled by having those tied, recomplete.

Q Do we have to house via you?

A No, but we believe our rate will be the best in Chicago. The housing information and form is on the website.

Q Can a judge volunteer to judge?

A Absolutely! Send an email to Karen at BTNI1@aol.com stating you wish to judge and include your resume. (Brief is fine)

Q What is the liaison the brochure notes?

A That is the person who would speak to David and Karen and field questions for your particular event.

Q Will this be an annual event?

A Yes and it will and it will hopefully be Memorial Day weekend. If that weekend is not available it will be either the weekend before or after.

Q Do/Can we bring our own floor?

A Yes. Whatever you normally do in your own circuits you should do in Chicago.

Q Is there a competition for younger twirlers and other events?

A YES, we have added a JUBILEE portion to the weekend. So many asked us to include other events to allow their twirlers the opportunity to compete and then also watch the Legends' Cup. There is a separate entry form for those JUBILEE entries inside the booklet. The JUBILEE will be scheduled for Saturday morning unless it is so large we need to utilize some of Friday afternoon. We will make that decision as entries come in.
