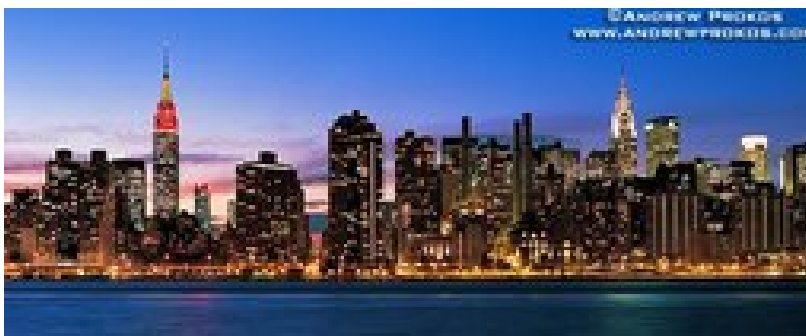

About our Winter Camp Facility in New Jersey

The meadowlands Exposition Center is located just 5 miles from New York City. Is easily accessible to all major highways in the area and Newark Liberty Airport. The center is surrounded by over 40 restaurants, movie theatres and retail stores. The Meadowlands Sports Complex is just three miles away and includes Giants Stadium, Continental Airlines Arena and the Meadowlands Racetrack. The hotel where campers who are housed will be accommodated is in the same complex as the Exposition Center and will offer a clean, safe and fun hub for all who are attending.
